Research area: Surface physics, surface chemistry, computational physics and quantum many-body theory. The applicant is required to have expertise in the adsorption of corrosive compounds on metal surfaces, a chemical background knowledge in insulating oils and material related to transformers, computational transformer oil research and sufficient knowledge of analytical, physical and inorganic chemistry

The successful applicant will be expected to engage in **full-time** postdoctoral studies within the School of Chemistry and Physics and to engage with chemists and physicists within this research area.

- Knowledge of physical and inorganic chemistry at least at third year level.
